1 . Presidential Note: Towards More Deepening and Intensifying Our Mutual Communications and Cooperations

Takeo Ihara, The 9th President of the ARSC

It is my great honor to be elected as the ninth president of the ARSC (Applied Regional Science Conference), with my tenure of two years starting from April 1, 2003. It was in 1987 when ARSC was founded as an academic organization. Since then, thanks to our members' great efforts, ARSC has contributed to promote interdisciplinary research of regional science through theoretical and policy-oriented approaches.

On the other hands, most of our universities and/or research institutes are now severely criticized in many ways. It is easy for us to say that those criticisms are too much myopic and they are also biased only by financial appraisal or market-oriented viewpoint. But, we should, at least, try to introspect ourselves so as to keep a pride and modesty as a seeker after truth. The raison d'etre for being an academic organization lies in encouraging as well as supporting each member of our organization by the various academic activities.

According to the Charter of the ARSC, our main objectives and policies are clearly

specified as follows: "ARSC aims to promote interdisciplinary research of regional science through theoretical and policy-oriented approaches." In addition, "ARSC pursues the following activities from a scholarly point of view."

- 1. To hold research meetings and symposia;
- 2. To publish research achievements of members through international academic journals and other media;
- 3. To exchange information with academic and other organizations throughout the world; and
- 4. To conduct other activities consistent with ARSC's objectives.

Therefore, I, as a president, will do my best to promote interdisciplinary research to the full extent by deepening and intensifying our mutual communications and cooperations. Among others, I also intend to put more emphasis on the following three activities: namely, to make our annual research meeting more attractive, to inform our members of more detail academic activities, and to facilitate more international communications. So, I am strongly looking forward to your continuing participation and cooperation. Thank you.

2. Election Result for Vice President

The election of the Vice President of ARSC was held by the mail-in voting period ended on March 20, 2003. Professor Masuo Kashiwadani (Ehime University) was elected. His term is from April 2003 to March 2005.

The sessions will be organized under the following common subjects. However the topic of individual papers need not be restricted to those subjects. Besides the general sessions, the Thinktank sessions and the special session "Regions" will also be organized.

- * Urban and Regional Analysis: City and Regional Systems, Urban and Regional Redevelopment, Informatics and Urban Centers, Congestion Problems, Migration, Land Use, Urban and Regional redevelopment
- * Transport: Urban Transport Systems, Toll and Charge for Motorway, ITS, TDM
- * Logistics: Intraurban and Interurban Freight, Out-Sourcing
- * Environmental Issues: Environmental Taxation, Global Warming, Energy Analysis
